ISSUE 4: APRIL 20, 2020

- 1. This week we initiated an Audio/Video story and Poem creation campaign, "Teachers as Narrators". In two days 19 audio stories/poems and 25 video stories/poems were finalized and shared.
- 2. 52 case studies of academic and non-academic projects of Samarth participants were shared. The total reach of each post was 75,147.
- 3. Scholars for Change (RJMCEI project of videos developed by interns) mobile-based application that was shared with teachers through various platforms has 100 plus installations this week. About 600 plus teachers are using this regularly.

- **5.** Resource person videos are also going on through Facebook/WhatsApp. Prashant Sharma created 10 videos this week on science for standards 6 to 8; he is a state resource group member.
- **6.** Teachers' online ICT workshops are ongoing and more teachers are joining now. Our contact in Maharashtra is also doing this. In this week, four workshops for about 300 teachers were conducted by the resource teachers.
- **7.** Student online classes are also ongoing (continuation of earlier work). Homework through WhatsApp groups is also on.
- **8.** "Online English Class" by Bipin Vasan, Mevan Primary School, Devbhumi Dwarka: For students of 5 to 8 Std. he has organized online English learning sessions using Zoom. Two sessions per day: morning from 10.00 to 11.00 and in the evening from 8.30 to 8.50. Average 45 students join the session. Till date 25 sessions have been completed.
- 9. Shree Gajanvvar Primary school, Dhrangadhra has organized an interesting competition named "LOCKDOWN HEROES OF GANJANVAV". In that, school gives different tasks daily through WhatsApp to the village (essay writing, handicraft work, volunteering for some tasks, drawing, etc.). 100 plus children have participated. Best three get prizes and the rest get E-certificate of participation.
- 10. Jayshreeben Jigneshbhai Raval, Vanagala Primary School, Unjha and Sitaraam Karshanbhai Raval, Lakshmipura Aithor Primary School, Unjha: These two teachers have joined hands to provide food kits to poor families. This week they have distributed 150 plus kits to poor families of Visnagar and Siddhpur. One kit costs 500 rupees. Each kit includes spices, potatoes, onion, flour, oil, sugar, rice and pulses. At the time of distribution, they have lectures on Corona virus and the precautions to be taken.
- 11. In another initiative Mihir Solanki, Vasant Parmar, and retired teacher Punbhai Parmar under the guidance of V. D Adhiyol, DIET Mahesana, raised money through WhatsApp for 35 food kits for poor families, each kit is costing 750 rupees. 15 teachers helped in this.
- 12. RPS Ropada Primary School Online Summer Camp Activities: The activity is going on with 3 groups and 423 members, with new members from Rajasthan, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and Maharashtra. Total 32 different kind of activities conducted till date (poster making, making lamps and various articles, and many other activities). Parents, students and teachers share their feedback in the group and through videos of what they have done. We have conducted 37 telephonic interviews of the

participants. The new initiative taken is sharing GK, History content, and homework through google form.







